#### SIGNIFICANTLY LOWER ON LAST.

#### **HIGH GROWN TEAS**

**BOP** Best Westerns declined Rs. 50 per kg and more for select high priced teas of last week. In the Below Best category, few select invoices were firm and dearer following special inquiry, whilst the others declined Rs. 30-40 per kg and more. Plainer clean leaf sorts were Rs. 10-20 per kg dearer, whilst the others were lower by a similar margin. Nuwara Eliyas - no offerings this week. Uva/Uda Pussellawas were up to Rs. 20 per kg lower.

**BOPF** Teas in the Best and Below Best categories declined Rs. 60-70 per kg and more following quality. Plainer sorts were Rs. 30-50 per kg easier. Nuwara Eliyas - hardly any offerings. Uva/Uda Pussellawas - select high priced teas of last week substantially easier, whilst the others were Rs. 20-40 per kg lower.

#### UNORTHODOX TEAS(CTC)

**<u>HIGH</u>** BP1s - Irregular. PF1s - Declined Rs. 30-40 per kg and more following quality. **GROWN** 

<u>MEDIUM</u> <u>GROWN</u> BP1s - Irregular. PF1s - Declined Rs. 20-40 per kg.

#### OFF GRADES

**FGS1/FGS** Best varieties decline Rs. 40-50 per kg whilst below best sorts maintained. Poorer sorts gained Rs. 5-10 per kg. Low Growns in general firm on last. CTC - Best together with below best varieties declined Rs. 20 per kg whilst poorer sorts were firm on last.

#### **DUSTS**

**DUST-1** Select best primaries declined Rs. 20-30 per kg and more. High Grown Dust1's in the best category which maintained quality sold at last weeks closing levels. Balance declined Rs. 20-30 per kg and more. Below best too followed a similar trend. Poorest on offer declined Rs. 20 per kg and more. Mediums declined Rs. 30-40 per kg. Select best CTC's declined sharply. CTC's in the best category firm to irregularly lower. Below best sold at last levels. Poorer sorts declined Rs. 10-20 per kg and more. Better Low Growns gained Rs. 10-20 per kg and

more following quality and special inquiry. Below best sold at last levels. Poorest on offer firm to irregularly dearer.

**<u>DUST</u>** Clean secondaries firm to irregularly dearer. Below best sold at last levels. Poorest on offer declined Rs. 10-20 per kg. CTC's sold at last weeks closing levels. Better Low Growns gained Rs. 10-20 per kg. Others were firm.

## LOW GROWN TEAS

<u>FBOP/</u> FBOP1	Select best and best FBOP's declined whilst cleaner below best and cleaner teas at the bottom were easier following quality. FBOP1's in general were easier.
<u>BOP</u> <u>BOP1</u> <u>OP1</u>	Select best and best were easier. Cleaner below best and cleaner teas at the bottom were firm. Others were lower following quality. Select best BOP1's declined substantially. All others were easier Rs. 10-20 per kg and more. Select best declined substantially. Others and below best too were easier Rs. 20-40 per kg and more. At the lower end cleaner types were fully firm to irregularly dearer. Balance were fairly steady.
<u>OP</u>	OP's declined Rs. 10-20 per kg and more.
<u>OPA</u>	Better OPA's declined Rs. 20-30 per kg whilst others and below best too were easier by a similar margin. At the lower end prices were firm to marginally easier.
<u>PEKOE</u>	A few select best PEK/PEK1's together with a range of bold PEK's maintained last levels. Others declined Rs. 10-20 per kg and more following quality. At the lower end PEK's were fully firm to marginally dearer whilst PEK1's were irregular.
BOPF	In general were easier.
<u>FBOPF/</u> FBOPF1	Very tippy teas continue to attract good demand. Best together with cleaner below best maintained. Others were easier following quality. Select best and best FF1's declined. However, cleaner below best and cleaner teas at the bottom were firm on last. Balance were easier following quality.
